





Museums



Campground sites and RV parks are located throughout the entire county. Enjoy amenities such as dog parks, horse riding trails, boat access, fishing and more. Try primitive camping on Bear Island at Hammocks Beach State Park.

Fishing

Come for recreational and deep-water sport fishing on the Intracoastal Waterway and beaches. On the New River and the White Oak River, reel in speckled trout,



red drum, flounder and largemouth bass. Hire a savvy fishing guide or charter for beginner or advanced trips. Visit NCWildlife.org for licensing rules.

Golf

Hit the links at one of our public golf courses in Jacksonville or play mini-golf. Head to the coast for a golf getaway package at Northshore Country Club and enjoy the natural beauty of the Intracoastal Waterway and the fun of golf in one setting.



Specialty Tours & Cruises

Take a chartered eco-tour or hop on a marsh cruise along the Intracoastal Waterway for a shelling excursion to Bear Island, or board a private yacht for a cruise along the New River and beyond. Many of our fishing charters also offer shrimping, crabbing and sunset excursions.

Water Recreation

All the fun you can imagine is out on the water. If you're new to paddling or a seasoned expert, top-of-the-line paddleboards and kayaks are available to rent. Assisted tours are available, including ecotours. Plus, rent jet skis, surfboards, beach bikes or a boat to explore our coastal waterways.



Marinas

Feel the sand between your toes With more than 30 miles of family-friendly,

gorgeous, uncrowded coastline to enjoy, Onslow County's sandy beaches are the perfect playground for everything from fishing to water sports or simply relaxing.

North Topsail Beach

Cross over the high-rise bridge and the Intracoastal Waterway to start your leisure vacation along the scenic shores of North Topsail Beach (NTB). Dogs are allowed and required to be kept on a 25-foot leash.

Onslow County Parks & Recreation offers parking along with restrooms and showers at no charge at three access points:

- Access 1 1795 New River Inlet Rd
- Access 2 2950 Island Dr.
- Access 4 484 New River Inlet Rd



The Town of NTB offers various paid parking accesses plus a 4x4 permissible driving area located at the north end of the island off River Road. Visitors must download the SurfCAST by Otto smartphone app to pay for a parking pass.

ONSLOW Beaches

Onslow Beach

Onslow Beach is located on Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune and open to all authorized DoD ID cardholders with proper base access. The beach features rental lodging units, an RV campground, pavilions with changing rooms, volleyball courts and guarded swimming areas from Memorial Day to Labor Day. Bear Island at Hammocks Beach State Park

Bear Island is a 4-mile-long, undeveloped barrier island accessible by the Hammocks Beach State Park passenger ferry that runs from April to October. Or make your way by private charter, canoe or kayak. Read more about Bear Island adventures on pages 19-21.





A hidden gem of natural and historic wonders

The warm sunshine on your face. The quiet that comes from being unplugged. Escape to the peaceful barrier island of Hammocks Beach State Park in Swansboro.



Your journey begins at the Visitor Center where the exhibits tell the story of the park's 1,500-acres, which includes three smaller islands - Dudley, Huggins and Jones.

The park's crown jewel, Bear Island, was ranked as one of Travel + Leisure's Top Ten NC Beaches. You'll relish the "back to nature" vibe of this island that is free of cars and houses. Get there via the park's ferry service that runs from April through October or with one of our specialty cruise operators offering eco-tours, shelling excursions and water taxi service.

Outdoor relaxation awaits on the wide beach between massive dunes and the ocean, interrupted only by primitive campsites and a modest concession and picnic complex. Make your camping reservations on the park's website.



Explore the natural wonders of the unspoiled maritime forest on a kayak or paddleboard. Bring your own equipment or rent from the park's onsite outfitter, Paddle NC. Dolphins, beautiful shorebirds and the occasional loggerhead sea turtle popping its head up to say "Hi!" are some of the amazing experiences to enjoy on your own or on a guided tour.

We've got trails of all kinds! Hike the 3 miles of coastal wooded trails on the mainland. Read more about paddling and birding trails on pages 21 and 22.

Wildlife aficionados will appreciate the park's interpretive educational programs about ecology, endangered sea turtles and nesting shorebirds. Learn about the diverse history of the land from Native Americans and African Americans to pirates, farmers and the military.

Paddling & Birding Trails

Paddling our waterways and discovering the many native species of birds and wildlife go hand-in-hand in Onslow County.

Hammocks Beach State Park is a great launch site to explore the three well-marked paddling trails leading to marshes, Bear Island or Huggins Island. Enjoy bird and wildlife sightings along the water surrounded by the unspoiled maritime forest. The trails range from 200 yards to more than 6 miles. Guided tours and rentals are available with Paddle NC.



The Cow Horn Trail is a 16.85-mile trail that runs along the New River from Steeds Park in Richlands to the New River Waterfront Park in Jacksonville.

North Topsail Beach's Permuda Island Coastal Reserve is one of the best kayaking and stand up paddle boarding (SUP) destinations in North Carolina. Kayak into the quiet waters of Stump Sound, and get lost in the sights and sounds of the salt marsh. Enjoy calm waters and almost zero motor boat traffic.

Biking Trails

Scenic routes and fun rides are available for cyclists of all levels to enjoy. From flat, shaded trails to long-distance routes, Onslow County offers miles of trails winding within the city of Jacksonville and stretching all the way to the coast.

Big Branch Bike Park - a 1.6-mile flow trail and a 4.6-mile intermediate mountain bike trail in Jacksonville. Great greenway loop trails for all levels.

Rails to Trails Greenway - a 6-mile trail through Jacksonville. Great for a beginner with no cars around.

Richlands Loop Trail - a 50-mile and shorter 20-mile road loop that runs through rural coastal plains of Onslow County.

City-to-Sea Trail - a 21-mile ride from Jacksonville Mall to Hammocks Beach State Park in Swansboro.



NC Mountains-to-Sea Trail

The NC Mountains-to-Sea Trail is as diverse as North Carolina traversing 1,175 miles across our state.

Spring through fall, come aboard Bayonet Cruises private yacht charter for a lunch or sunset adventure. We're famous for speckled trout and more; spend a day casting for fun with our fishing guides. They provide everything.

Hearts race with sports and running. You'll find no shortage of athletic challenges here, from the Grand Prix Series strength and endurance races hosted aboard Camp Lejeune to our New River Splash Triathlon. Nail biting soccer, softball, boxing and other tournaments find their way to Jacksonville throughout the year.

Savor the globe. Dine at our authentic ethnic restaurants started by families who visited the area

and stayed or relocated here after service at Camp Lejeune. Choose from a worldwide selection of craft beer and wine for your visit at Wines & Wares or drop by The Milk Road for Liège waffles and singleorigin coffee pour-overs.

Western boulevard hosts a wide variety of attractively priced brand name hotels and restaurants. Our "strip" caters to the tastes of traveling military personnel and families from across America. We offer a collection of chain retail and dining here you may not have encountered, even in larger cities.



Enjoy family time. Parks of all sizes and extensive bike paths invite families to get outdoors. Head about 30 minutes south to North Topsail Beach or east to experience four miles of pristine beach on Bear Island, part of Hammocks Beach State Park. (Check the state park website for ferry information to Bear Island before you go.) Cracked It! Escape Games and Altitude Trampoline Park offer places to burn off energy and bond. Zing Zumm provides an afternoon of fun for little ones.

See Ospreys in nests and in the sky. Pause when you hear the rumbling of the MV-22 Osprey flying overhead. With the ability to fly like a plane and take off and land like a helicopter, this aircraft was largely developed in Jacksonville. When near the water's edge, you may catch a flash of live osprey (a large hawk that lives near the water) diving into the river or sound for a fish. Onslow County boasts one of the highest concentrations of ospreys of either kind on the eastern seaboard.





Stroll our public gardens and visit our memorials

Each memorial connects the story of our country to this city and to American life today. Develop a new appreciation for the sacrifices of our service men and women—and their families—when you walk these winding paths.

Lejeune Memorial Gardens includes the Beirut Memorial, the Onslow Vietnam Veterans Memorial, the Montford Point Marine Memorial and 9/11 Memorial Beam from the World Trade Center. You'll also walk by the world's largest 3-D Eagle, Globe and Anchor. Park for free at the entrance on Montford Landing Road.

Beirut Memorial

With the exception of soldiers from Paris, all of the Marines killed at the Beirut Bombing on October 23, 1983 in Lebanon were based at Camp Lejeune.



The bombing is now viewed as the opening salvo in the War on Terrorism. The words "They Came In Peace" reflect how the men on assignment were present as peacekeepers. The names of each man lost are engraved in granite.

Vietnam Veterans Memorial

The memorial honors the men and women who served in the Vietnam War. The second largest Vietnam Veterans Memorial in the nation, the dome and fountain are surrounded with a glass wall. The names of 58,220 lost Americans are etched in the glass in alphabetical order.



Montford Point Marine Memorial

The Montford Point Marine Memorial is dedicated to the legacy of nearly 20,000 Black Marines who served in the Marine Corps from 1942 to 1949. They trained separately from their white counterparts at Montford Point Camp, now known as Camp Johnson. The memorial tells the story through architecture and sculpture. The statue indicates their uphill climb toward equality. The wall of 20,000 stars reflects the unknown names. No official record survives.

9/11 Memorial Beam

Delivered by a New York City Fire Truck, this beam from the Twin Towers was presented by police and firefighters of New York to Camp Lejeune in 2003. The first responders recognized that the Marines were the first deployed in the global war on terror. The beam honors the 343 firefighters who perished on September 11, 2001.




